County is still working on their CWPP. \$28,000 for a Perry Park 36 acre shaded fuel break was awarded. Larkspur Properties will begin its phase 3 with 26 acres to be done by Seedmasters. Renaissance Festival in talks about oak mitigation, forest management and wildfire mitigation. Roxborough Park emergency easement is opening.
