 - ii. Kyle said they have finished a 5 acre mitigation project at the Cheyenne Mountain Zoo and working on a 25 acre mitigation project on the Woodman Valley Open Space.
 - iii. Dave said that the Black Forest Slash site is now closed for the season after a record year of around 18,500 loads of slash dropped off.
 - iv. Andrew said that the 45 acre mitigation project off highway 115 is about ¼ finished. He also talked about the 200 acre Cedar Heights mitigation project.
 - v. Diane said that the AFA is thinning in Jack's Valley.
 - b. Douglas County:
 - i. Randy said that Douglas County is progressing on the county CWPP and is having initial public meeting within the fire districts.
 - ii. Keith talked about the Roxborough EEE work, that the Woodlands/Escavera project in Castle Rock is wrapping up and that the Larkspur Fire Mitigation Crew is about ready to release the seasonal employees for the year.

- c. Teller County:
 - i. Dave talked about the CUSP ARRA projects - that the Ridgewood landowners are going to do a fuel break
 - ii. Dave said that 25 acres on the Catamount Open Space is getting mitigated.
 - iii. Brent said that 3055 acres has been treated on Pikes Peak Rd.
