 - b. Douglas: Lots of calls for mitigation assessments. WUI drill for Perry Park April 30th. Larkspur filed for a FEMA grant to keep the wild land fire crew on staff. Woodland Escavera is having an organizational meeting the week of the 17th. Twisted Timber and Happy Canyon completed with CUSP money by Rampart. Roxborough going to bid soon. Dakan Road project in operation, and May 21st is Valley Park educational day.
 - c. Teller: CWPP for Sanborn Camp approved. New CWPP North Lake north of the Divide and Colo. Mtn. estates. Colo. Springs. utility doing pre work for a prescribed fire in watershed. Has 200 acres upcoming for mitigation. Ridgewood CUSP work nearly completed. Divide slash/mulch program opening in April.
